Eligibility

Requirements for application include:

- Must be an honorably discharged veteran. Current or surviving spouses or Gold Star Parents are eligible based on the veterans eligibility
- Must be eligible for VA Medical benefits
- Must be an Iowa resident
- Must have a medical need for care

Cost of Care

Eligible applicants are admitted without regard to their financial status. The rate of payment is based on the actual cost of care and the individual's ability to pay using available resources. The cost for nursing level of care for veterans with a combined 70% service connected disability or higher is covered by the VA.

Choice

Choose among many on and off campus recreational activities including social events, live music and dancing, special meals, bike rides, outdoor games and movies. We also have scheduled trips including shopping, dining out, sporting and community events. If we don't offer it, just ask! New suggestions are always welcome! IVH offers special areas on campus for family overnight stays, reunions, visits and cookouts. We also offer on-site cosmetology services, a gift shop, library, computer lab with internet, laundry services and wheelchair services.
