TOP PRIORITIES

- Property Tax Relief: We fully support Disabled Veterans rated 10% through 90% having their property taxes offset by the percentage of their United States Department of Veteran Affairs Disability Compensation Rating.
- 2. <u>Iowa Veterans Trust Fund Modernization:</u> We fully support revisions to Iowa Code 35A.13 that would raise the terminal balance of the Iowa Veterans Trust Fund from \$50 to \$75 million and continue the annual \$500,000 transfer from the Iowa Lottery **that supports the Commission's efforts to assist Iowa veterans in need.**
- 3. <u>IDVA Code Revision:</u> We fully support an update to Iowa Code that removes a single accrediting organization for training, the National Association of County Veterans Service Officers, as the sole option for county VSOs, **allowing greater flexibility and options** with a number of additional organizations.
- 4. <u>Veterans Treatment Courts:</u> We fully support legislation to **establish and expand** Veterans Treatment Courts.
- 5. <u>Support Veteran Service Organizations:</u> We fully support proposals for *partial grants* to help maintain Veteran Service Organization officers and services currently co-located in downtown Des Moines.

AWARENESS ISSUES:

- A) We support any legislation that will improve *Mental Health* support and *Suicide Prevention* for our veterans, their families, and all lowans.
- B) We support legislation that supports the needs of *homeless and under-served veterans*.
- C) We support legislation to align Iowa Code with Federal Code regarding the timing and manner of display of the *National League of POW/MIA families' flag* on all State of Iowa properties.
- D) We support full implementation of federal legislation **S.141-Senator Elizabeth Dole 21**st **Century Veterans Healthcare and Benefits Improvement Act**, which became law on 1/2/25.
