TOP PRIORITIES

- Property Tax Relief: We fully support Disabled Veterans rated 10% through 90% having their property taxes offset by the percentage of their United States Department of Veteran Affairs Disability Compensation Rating.
- Protecting Veteran VA Benefits: We strongly oppose any legislation that will in any way diminish VA
 benefits paid to lowa veterans by modifying lowa Code 546B to allow for-profit 'claim sharks' to operate
 in the state.
- CVSO Excellence: We fully support legislation that encourages efficiencies, innovation, incentivization of high performance, and increased minimum hours in the county veteran service officer system.
- 4. <u>Support Veteran Service Organizations:</u> We fully support proposals for *partial grants* to help maintain Veteran Service Organization officers and services currently co-located in downtown Des Moines.
